2016 FALL BRUSH CHIPPING

SEPTEMBER 26 - OCTOBER 7, 2016

- Brush must be placed at the roadside edge of your property, stacked neatly with the cut ends toward the roadway.
- Limbs should be cut in **4 to 12 foot lengths, no bigger than 4 inches in diameter.**
- Trash, thorny materials, plants, leaves, grass, bamboo, root balls, wood with nails or wire, dirt, or rocks **will not** be chipped or picked up.
- Please leave the sidewalk clear in front of your property, if one exists, for pedestrian traffic.
- Place all trimmings at the curbside the weekend **before** September 26, 2016.

Our Public Works crews will pick up brush in **DISTRICT 2** from **SEPTEMBER 26, 2016, through OCTOBER 7, 2016.**

Brush must be placed at the curbside no later than the evening of Sunday, September 25, 2016.

THERE WILL BE ONLY 1 (ONE) PASS MADE THROUGH EACH DISTRICT.

2016 FALL LEAF COLLECTIONS

FIRST LEAF COLLECTION:

NOVEMBER 1 - 7, 2016

- Leaves should be raked to the roadside and stacked in a manner that does not obstruct sidewalks or ditches.
- Please be sure to remove all rocks, glass, branches or other hard materials.
- Bagged leaves will not be collected by the City's Public Work crews.
- Bags with attached yard waste tags may be placed out for the Trash Hauler to pick up on regular trash days.

Leaves must be placed at the curbside no later than the evening of Monday, October 31, 2016.

SECOND LEAF COLLECTION:

NOVEMBER 29 - DECEMBER 5, 2016

- Same requirements listed above will apply to the second leaf collection.

Leaves must be placed at the curbside no later than the evening of Monday, November 28, 2016.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL COLLECTION DATES MAY FLUCTUATE DUE TO WEATHER CONDITIONS.

2017 CHRISTMAS TREE PICKUP

JANUARY 10, 2017

Trees must be placed at the curbside on the evening of Monday, January 9, 2017.

THERE WILL BE ONLY 1 (ONE) PASS MADE THROUGH EACH DISTRICT.

Christmas trees and brush (no leaves) may be dropped off at the Public Works Mulch Facility between dawn and dusk.

REFUSE ORDINANCE REMINDER

All refuse, which is accumulated in the City and offered for disposal, should be kept behind the front line of the residence, except at times of collection.

For residences on corner lots (fronting on two streets) the front line of the house shall be deemed to exist on the side containing the front entrance to the residence.

No container(s) shall be placed at the curb collection point prior to 4:00 p.m. the day before collection, and must be removed from the curb collection point on the same day.

If these requirements cannot be met, a limited waiver may be obtained from the City.
