

Refunds may be partial or prorated based on the type of program and time of cancellation and will be assessed a \$5.00 service charge.

- Refunds will not be given for EDGE Aquatic Center memberships.

If you register for a program and then realize that you would like to withdraw because of a scheduling conflict, before the program starts, a refund will be given if your position is filled by another participant. After the program begins, no refund will be given.

Rental Information



Pavilion Rentals

Pavilions in Bluebird Park are available to rent. Water and electric are turned on in the beginning of April and turned off at the end of October, weather permitting.

Bussmann Pavilion

Accommodates approximately **125** people. This pavilion is equipped with water, electric, and (2) barbeque grills. The renter has the option to book Conner Field if available.

Fee: \$55.00/day (\$35.00/day Resident)

Lions Pavilion

Accommodates approximately **100** people. This pavilion is equipped with water, electric, (1) barbeque grill and is located near the playground.

Fee: \$55.00/day (\$35.00/day Resident)

Bluebird Pavilion

Accommodates approximately **10** people. This pavilion is equipped with (1) bbq grill.

Fee: \$35.00/day (\$25.00/day Resident)

Ball Field Rentals



Conner Field and Field #2 are available on an hourly basis, Monday through Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. starting Monday, March 6, 2017 through Tuesday, October 31, 2017.

- Conner Field is located by the Bussmann Pavilion and is considered the upper field.
- Field #2 is considered the lower field.

Pavilion & Ball Field Rental Policies

- Online reservations!
- Renter is required to have receipt showing documentation of the reservation during the facility rental.
- Payment for all rentals is due at the time of reservation.
- For all pavilion rentals, cancellations made 30 days or more prior to the reservation date will receive a full refund. If the reservation is made less than 30 days prior to the reservation date, there will be no refunds given.
- For all ball field rentals, no refunds will be given. To transfer a practice date the renter will need to request it in writing with 30 days notice.
- City of Ellisville is not responsible for property lost, stolen or damaged.

Room Rental Policies

- Payment is due at the time of reservation. Your rental request is not confirmed until park staff receives the signed permit.
- There is an additional fee assessed for each hour beyond normal operating hours. After hour rentals require a (2) hour minimum. \$20.00/hour for Residents and Resident Businesses and \$30.00/hour for Non-Residents and Non-Resident Businesses.
- All meeting room rentals require **30** days notice for after-hour rentals. Black out periods for room rentals will be on city holidays or the weekend adjoining the city holiday.
- Cancellations made within **14** days from the time of the date of issue will receive a full refund. Cancellations made up to **30** days prior to the reservation date will receive a 50% refund.
- The City of Ellisville is not responsible for property lost, stolen or damaged.

5.78 acres includes multi-use trail.

Multi-use trail and natural park space.

Bluebird Park Tennis Courts

Ellisville Bike Share Bikes will be available April 1, 2017

Riding a bike can be a lot of fun, a great low impact cardio workout and a wonderful way to enjoy outdoors and explore your community. There are six bicycles that are available to ride in Bluebird Park and the surrounding area. The bikes are unisex and easily adjusted to fit riders that are 5' and over. To use a bike just come to the Ellisville Park Administration Building in Bluebird Park and obtain your membership. After you have an Ellisville Bike Share Membership, you will be given a code to unlock the bike and instructions on how to use the bikes. Memberships are free for Ellisville Residents and \$10 per non-resident individual and \$20 per non-resident family. Individuals must be at least 18 years old to obtain a membership and provide a valid driver's license or state I.D. A helmet should be worn but is not provided. Community Garden in Bluebird Park for Ellisville Residents

Are you interested in having a place to grow vegetables, flowers or herbs? Is your yard too shady or do you have too many deer to have a garden? If the answer is yes, you may be interested in the new community garden in Bluebird Park.

The garden will include individual planting plots, access to water and a fence around the perimeter to keep deer from helping themselves to your garden. The site is located between the Oak Hill Trail and ballfields in Bluebird Park. The goal is to have the garden ready for planting by April 15, 2017. As the garden is being constructed this winter/spring this date is weather permitting.

The annual fee for a 4'X8' plot is \$25 for Ellisville residents. You can apply for one of the 40 plots online www.ellisville.mo.us on the Parks and Recreation page or at or at the Park Administration Building in Bluebird Park. Ellisville Dog Park

The Ellisville Dog Park has two separate areas for small and large dogs. The large dog area is .28 acres and the small dog area is .11 acres. Dog water fountains are provided in each dog park area. The park is located in the back of Bluebird Park between the Bussmann Shelter and the ball fields adjacent to the back parking lot.

The Dog Park is open to Ellisville residents as well as those living outside the City. Each dog is issued and must wear their Ellisville tag at the dog park. Dog Park hours are dawn to dusk daily (there may be times when the park is closed for events, repairs, or due to inclement weather.)

Annual Dog Park Memberships are \$40.00 (up to 3 dogs per household) and are available online at our website www.ellisville.mo.us or at the Park Administration Center in Bluebird Park Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. To register your dog, you will need documentation showing proof that the dog has been spayed or neutered, and current rabies and bordetella vaccinations.

Back by popular demand, there will be a Free Dog Park Open House on Saturday, May 6 from 10:00 a.m. – 12 noon. It's a great chance to try out the dog park before becoming a member, and it's also an excellent time for current members to meet other dog park members and their dogs. There was a big turnout at the first open house in 2016. If you aren't a member, proof of Rabies and Bordetella vaccinations is required.

When your registration is complete your Team Unify account will be activated within 48 hours, and then you will receive an email with instructions on how to sign up for your work assignments. Volunteer shift sign-ups will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

Work Assignments

All families will be required to sign up for (2) volunteer shifts, in addition to conference meets if your swimmer participates.

Swim Team Assessments

All new swimmers will be assessed during the first week of practice. During the assessments, swimmers may not stop and/or grab the wall or lap lane. We do not expect your swimmer to have a perfect stroke. These steps are taken for safety precautions, as we want to ensure your swimmer is able to meet the requirements needed for practices and meets. If your swimmer is unable to meet the specific skills required, a full refund will be given.

Practices and Meets

The season lasts from May 30 - July 20, Monday-Friday. Regular season meets typically take place on weekdays with warm-ups beginning at 5:30 p.m. and meets beginning at 6:00 p.m. More information will be available during registration (see dates on page 2) and at the Parent Meetings which is scheduled for Tuesday, May 16 at 6:30 p.m.


